BCCIE International Education Awards will be decided by peer committee and will be as awarded in the following categories:

1 International Education Distinguished Leadership Award

This award recognizes the unique and important accomplishments and contributions of an international educator or member of the community who has effected change and leadership in the field of international education and whose work will have a lasting impact.

2 International Education Distinguished Service Award

This award recognizes the unique and important accomplishments and contributions of an international educator or member of the community who has 'led from behind', who through determined years of service has supported the students, activities and community of the field of international education.

3 Innovation in International Marketing Award

This award recognizes innovation and success in support of the education export sector in British Columbia and in the marketing of our world-class education system.

4 Rising Star in International Education Award

This award recognizes tomorrow's leaders, our up-and-coming talent, and the next generation of leaders and practitioners in the field of international education.

5 Outstanding Program in International Education

This new award is given to an institution, district or program to recognize high quality and highly creative programming in international education.

BCCIE INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION AWARDS NOMINATION FORM

Eligibility Criteria and Application Process

BCCIE will accept nominations for its 2012 International Education Awards Program from colleagues working at BC public school districts, recognized independent schools within BC, EQA-designated public and private post-secondary institutions (including private career colleges) and EQA-designated language schools. All nominees must have worked in BC for a minimum of twelve months prior to the nomination deadline of April 15, 2012.

As nominator, you are responsible for submitting a complete nomination form, and for identifying and soliciting references from two additional colleagues in support of the nomination. You should indicate clearly the award category under consideration, complete all fields in the nomination form, and ensure that you have understood and agreed to the terms and conditions of the nomination process. In order to keep the selection process fair, any additional documentation (additional reference letters, CVs, etc) will be discarded and not considered by the awards committee. The awards committee will consist of peer representatives of all international education stakeholder communities in BC. BCCIE staff will not take part in the selection process except to coordinate the nomination process. A shortlist of candidates will be announced in early May and profiled in the months leading up to the International Awards Gala on June 26, 2012.
